2015 VW Challenge starts at Midvaal

Meintjies (Performance Masters / Marty's Body & Spray Polo) will be doing their best to stop him taking the Class A honours. Iain Stevenson showed some impressive form in the second Comsol Polo during 2014 and will be looking to build on that to consistently challenge the class leaders in 2015.

With 2014 Class B title winner Lyle Ramsay moving on to compete in the Engen VW Cup series for 2015 the only certainty is that there will be a new champion at the end of the season. Based on form at the end of last season Darren Nathan and Tyrell Govindsamy are the most likely to emerge at the top of the log but they are not going to have things all their own way. Newcomers Lindsay Clur and Mile Stewart will be out to show what they are made of while series regulars Piet Potgieter and Brad Hall (Piazza Motorsport) are more than capable of running at the sharp end of the field in their Polos.
